

VA TUITION AND FEE POLICY

As part of the Veterans Benefits and Transition Act of 2018, section 3679 of title 38, United States Code was amended, and educational institutions will be required to comply with this requirement.

Students interested in applying for VA benefits (Covered Individuals), will be required to submit and adhere to the following requirements to ensure timely and accurate processing of their benefits:

- 1. Student must submit a Certificate of Eligibility (COE) for entitlement to educational assistance no later than the first day of a course of education.
- 2. Student must submit a written request to use such entitlement.
- 3. Student must provide additional information necessary to the proper certification of enrollment by the educational institution.
- 4. Institution may also require additional payment or impose a fee for the amount that is the difference between the amount of the student's financial obligation and the amount of the anticipated or actual VA education benefit disbursement.

PLEASE NOTE: A *Covered Individual* is any individual who is entitled to educational assistance under Chapter 31, Vocational Rehabilitation and Employment, or Chapter 33, Post-9/11 GI Bill® benefits.

Per the *Title 38 United States Code Section 3679(e)*, Nevada Career Institute (NCI) will not impose any penalty, including the assessment of late fees, the denial of access to classes, libraries, or other institutional facilities, or the requirement that a covered individual borrow additional funds, on any covered individual because of the individual's inability to meet his or her financial obligations to the institution due to the delayed disbursement funding from VA under chapter 31 or 33.
